By Using Our Site, You Accept These Terms and Conditions

Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully and ensure that you understand them before using Our Site.

2. Information About Us

4. Access to Our Site

- 4.1 Access to Our Site is free of charge.
- 4.2 It is your responsibility to make the arrangements necessary in order to access Our Site.

16. Communications from Us

- 16.1 If we have your contact details, we may send you notices by email from time to time. Such notices may relate to matters including, but not limited to, changes to Our Site or to these Terms and Conditions.
- 16.2 We will not send you marketing emails without your express consent. If you do consent to marketing, you may opt out at any time. All marketing emails from Us include an unsubscribe link. If you opt out of emails from Us, it may take a short time for your request to take effect and you may continue to receive emails during that time.

17. Law and Jurisdiction
